Job Description

The City of Fort Lauderdale with 180,000 full-time residents and an operating budget of over \$400 million, and 2600 employees is seeking qualified candidates to fill the position of Fire Chief.

The Fire Rescue Department is a Class 3 department with a \$65.5 million dollar budget and 464 employees (383 sworn) responsible for providing firefighting services and advance life support to city residents. Additionally, the department provides fire-rescue services to the city's Executive Airport and has an Ocean Rescue Division that covers some of Fort Lauderdale's beaches. Last year, the department handled more than 41,000 calls for service.

A bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university in Fire Science or Fire Management, Public Administration, or other related field is required; graduation from the National Fire Academy Executive Fire Officer or Chief Fire Officer Program or a master's degree preferred.
