

TITLE: Deputy Chief-Operations

PURPOSE: Directs and administers Operations, Safety and Training and Special Operations Divisions having responsibility for operational readiness, response standardization and performance management.

JOB REQUIREMENTS AND QUALIFICATIONS

- A. **EDUCATION LEVEL:** Bachelors degree or equivalent professional experience. Masters degree preferred. Graduate of a Chief Fire Officer Management or equivalent Executive Officer or Leadership program preferred.
- B. **EXPERIENCE IN FIELD:** Minimum of 10 years experience in an airport, municipal and/or military emergency service. Minimum of 5 years in a supervisory or management position.
- C. **UNIQUE EXPERIENCE/CERTIFICATION/REGISTRATIONS:**
1. Massachusetts Class D (III) unrestricted except for corrective lenses.
 2. Ability to pass airfield driving test and obtain aerodrome license.
 3. Ability to pass Massport Security clearance and obtain a Massport security badge.
 4. Working knowledge of appropriate strategy and tactics with all hazard emergency operations and related threats to transportation systems.
 5. Experience in a unionized work environment.
 6. Knowledge and understanding of FAA regulations governing airport rescue and firefighting services at Index E airports.
 7. Working knowledge of airport safety, emergency medical and fire service national standards.
 8. Working knowledge of state and federal environmental regulations relative to hazardous material responder responsibilities and requirements.
 9. Ability to pass an in service wellness exam (every 2 years).
 10. Ability to pass Massport pre-placement physical and controlled substance testing.
